Dear Dr. Riedel,

"Kerry", a 7 Yrs. 11 Mos. old Female Irish Setter belonging to the Holt family, presented to California Veterinary Specialists for Caesarean section. The clients imported the dog from Ireland 10 days ago as a pregnant breeding female. A reproductive work-up the following day showed several live puppies. She was started on a wormer as she was emaciated on arrival, and she has gained 7 lbs since. This morning she was noticed to have brown copious discharge from her vulva. She did eat this morning (she is free fed) and no vomiting or lethargy have been observed.

On presentation she was alert and appeared fairly well hydrated. No murmur was auscultated, and lungs were clear. Mucous membranes were pink, moist and CRT 1 - 2 seconds. On abdominal palpation the uterus appeared to contain one puppy. The fur surrounding her vulva was wet and there was brown thick discharge in the vulva. Her abdomen was non-painful on palpation. Milk was expressed from her mammarys but she was not very engorged. No puppies were present in the vaginal canal. An ultrasound showed one puppy with heart rate comparable to Kerry's, and no other obvious fetuses were found. We recommended a Caesarean section which the clients approved, although they expressed a desire to keep Kerry intact to breed. Pre-operative lab work was unremarkable. Propofol/ Isoflurane anesthesia was administered and Caesarean section performed, and one viable puppy was removed and resuscitated, although the puppy has been a little weak and has not been able to nurse vigorously so was tube fed. Kerry had thick tan tenacious discharge throughout both horns of the uterus, and a sample was submitted for culture. We consulted with the clients intra-operatively about ovariohysterectomy and again they elected to keep her intact. Oxytocin was given after closure of the uterine incision to help expel the material. Recovery was unremarkable. We plan to start Baytril IV, continue IF fluids and analgesics, and if she recovers well may discharge her later tonight pending culture results. We will dispense Baytril 135 mg #7 (1 tablet PO SID) and Tramadol 50 mg #20 (1 tablet PO TID PRN for pain).

Dear Dr. Riedel,

"Kerry" Holt was discharged late yesterday evening after recovering well from Caesarean section. The puppy was not vigorous enough to nurse so was tube fed twice. Kerry did not have very much milk but did let-down a little more after an oxytocin injection. We dispensed a one week course of Baytril (136 mg PO SID) pending culture of the uterine fluid, and also dispensed Tramadol. I spoke with the client today who reports that Kerry is continuing to do well, and the puppy is nursing well from another lactating bitch in the household. We will forward the culture results when available.
